




So, what really is Gatsby?


### What Is Gatsby?

- A blazing fast React-based static site generator
- An application framework
- Connects to multiple APIs
- Build JAMstack sites
- Hydrates to a React app




### Why not Gatsby?

- Content not available immediately
- No incremental builds (yet) for WordPress



#### React

- Replaces the view layer of your application
- Declarative, Composable and Reusable Components
- Write HTML (JSX) within JavaScript
- Virtual DOM




### GraphQL

- Ask for what you need, get exactly that
- An alternative to REST API
- Single endpoint
- Get many resources in a single request
- Created by Facebook, now open source







### 2 Ways

1. Using WordPress REST API



2. Using WPGraphQL



#### 1. Using WordPress REST API

- Install <u>gatsby-source-wordpress</u> plugin
- Fetches from WordPress REST API at build time
- Converts data to stitched GraphQL schema
- No extra WordPress plugins needed
- Can cause issues later on
- WordPress Source Plugin Tutorial

### 2. Using WPGraphQL

- Install <u>gatsby-source-graphql</u> plugin
- Fetches from GraphQL and stitches the schema
- Needs <u>WPGraphQL</u> plugin
- Faster
- More scalable



### WPGraphQL

- Exposes WordPress data as GraphQL schema
- Open source project
- Created by <u>Jason Bahl</u>
- Install a WordPress plugin
- Has add-ons for ACF and more...

# Starting a Gatsby Project

• • •

npm install --global gatsby-cli
gatsby new my-project
cd my-project

gatsby develop

# Enter Gatsby Themes

### Gatsby Themes

- Abstract away code into a separate package
- Let end user focus on content
- Use multiple themes on the same project
- Child theme support



### Gatsby WP Themes

- Porting WordPress themes to Gatsby
- Initiated by <u>Zac Gordon</u>
- Twenty Nineteen Gatsby Theme
- Tabor Gatsby Theme


