Start with colleagues, friends, and family members




Recruit volunteers from your audience

How to Design a Usability Test: Questions to Ask



Start with #goals.



Questions about the tester and how they interact with the internet.



Feedback about each individual page on your website.



What do you make of (specific element)?



Define a specific action for the user to take.



How to design better user testing questions:

Avoid web development/industry-specific jargon.

Break up complicated questions into simpler ones.

Be as specific as possible when asking questions.



The questions I ask:

What's the URL of your website/app?

Feel free to send this ahead of an order for me to check out, if you'd like!

Are there any major problems that you want me to keep in mind throughout the process?


Can you briefly describe your target customer so that I can keep their perspective in focus?

What important goals are you hoping that this page/these pages will achieve?


Record User Sessions with Inspectlet




